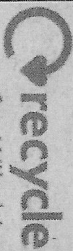

# Inspired by the Flavours of India

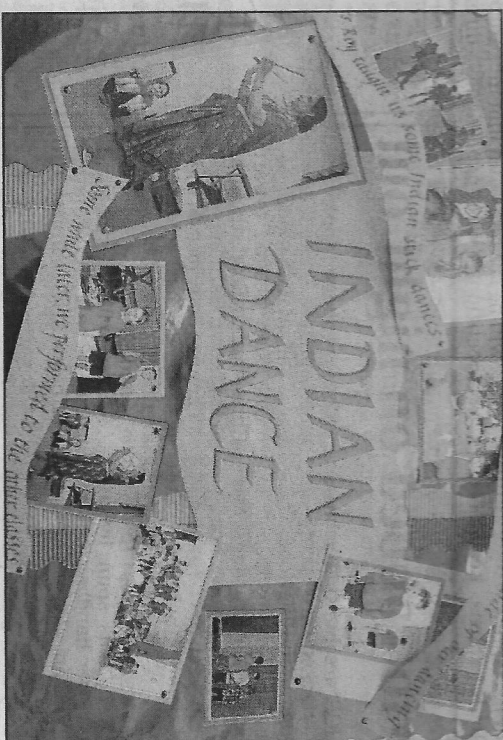
**YOUNGSTERS** explored India to produce an impressive array of artwork, food and a video of dance and music.
